Statement of Ethical Obligations

Oath or Affirmation of Office

In taking the Oath or Affirmation of Office, each Councillor has made a commitment to undertake the duties of the office of councillor in the best interests of the people of Cumberland and Cumberland City Council and that they will faithfully and impartially carry out the functions, powers, authorities and discretions vested in them under the Local Government Act 1993 or any other Act to the best of their ability and judgment.

Conflicts of Interest

A councillor who has a conflict of interest in any matter with which the council is concerned, and who is present at a meeting of the council when the matter is being considered, must disclose the interest and the nature of the interest to the meeting as soon as practicable. Both the disclosure and the nature of the interest must be recorded in the minutes of the Council meeting where the conflict of interest arises. Councillors should ensure that they are familiar with Parts 4 and 5 of the Code of Conduct in relation to their obligations to declare and manage conflicts of interests.

MAYORAL MINUTE - CONDOLENCES - BONDI JUNCTION WESTFIELD TRAGEDY

SUMMARY

On the afternoon of Saturday 13 April 2024, a tragic act of violence against innocent shoppers occurred at the Bondi Junction Westfield Shopping Centre.

Six people were killed in the attack and a further twelve were seriously injured, including a 9-month-old child whose mother lost her life in the attack. Our community is in shock and disbelief.

This evening, I extend my deepest condolences to the loved ones of those that lost their lives. To those injured, my thoughts and wishes for a full and speedy recovery are with you and your families.

My thoughts are also for those who were there at the time and witnessed this terrible act of violence, and for those who, on learning of this attack, experienced distress and sorrow having recalled previous trauma from their own past. I wish you all comfort and peace during this difficult time.

Thank you for the efforts and hard work of our NSW Police, emergency services and health professionals, and other first responders. These people are always there in times of need and act with courage and selflessness. I also wish to thank the members of the public who bravely stepped into assist, risking their own well-being to help others. Your actions during the incident undoubtedly saved many lives.

Therefore Councillors, tonight I move the following:

RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

- 1. Note with sadness the six lives that were lost, those injured, and the shock and trauma this tragedy has caused to those present at the time and the community more broadly; and
- 2. Observe a minute's silence to honour the six lives that have been tragically lost.
